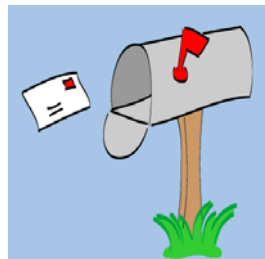
*** Mark Your Calendar:**
