

# Youth Camp Rules and Dress Code

## Cell Phones

- Cell phones must be turned in upon arrival at camp.
- If a cell phone is used inappropriately it will be taken away for the remainder of the bus trip.

## Ipods/MP3's/Movies

- All electronics and other materials not permitted at camp must be turned in upon arrival at camp.
- Movies and mp3's will be allowed ONLY during the drive up and back.
- All movies must be PG-13 rating or under. (Please use discretion when selecting videos\*)
- Please keep music clean.\*

\*All items are subject to approval. Any items not deemed appropriate or being used irresponsibly may be confiscated.

## Clothing-Girls

- NO Pajamas for the bus ride up or back, as we will be stopping for meals.
- Girls may wear loose fitting, knee-length shorts or jeans for any activities.
- Skirts and tops are to be of modest length (no skin should show in the midriff area) and shirts should not be too low in the collar area.
- Sleeveless shirts are permitted as long as they are modest under the arm.
- No spaghetti straps, tank tops or halter tops.
- Denim is allowed.
- One pair of water shoes is recommended. (NO flip-flops or sandals for water activities)
- Girls must wear appropriate shorts and a dark t-shirt over their bathing suit for all water activities.
- Remember, modesty is so when in doubt, DON'T!

## Clothing-Guys

- NO Pajamas for the bus ride up or back, as we will be stopping for meals.
- Guys may wear shorts (no shorter than your fingertips) or jeans for all activities.
- NO Tank tops.
- Denim is allowed.
- One pair of tennis shoes or hiking boots are recommended for the guys.
- Guys must wear swimming trunks or appropriate length shorts with a dark t-shirt for all water activities.
- One pair of water shoes is recommended. (NO flip-flops or sandals for water activities)
- Remember, modesty is key so when in doubt, DON'T!
